Note on song:

The chorus of this song is brief, and is the D-Em-C portion of 'verse/chorus' rich vocal harmony is great here. Note that the chorus is extended by four measures on Verse/chorus 2 and verse/chorus 3 compared to the first section. The simply D-C (5th-4th) extension is not present following the Jam section, however.
